****Open to ponies/horses ch/ad 1st/2nd yr. not shown more than specified height. Classes split as needed according to entries. May move up at one show.**

Please Note: the classes held in the Beginner Ring will run concurrently with the large ring & will have a separate judge. They will be conducted as "mini-clinics" with feedback given in each class. Management has the right to use only one judge & run classes consecutively depending on "turn-out". Beginner ring will still receive feedback.

Student Equitation is open to both beginner adults & children. Adults entering Student Eq. may also show in Pleasure & Low Hunter.

Riders showing in VHSA/USHJA classes may pay an additional fee to have points count for the USHJA; otherwise the class will only count for VHSA.
