Limit Rider Hunter: Open to horses and ponies ridden by Juniors and Adult Amateurs who are not entered in any classes jumping 2'6" or higher.

Low Hunter: Open to all horses and ponies; no rider restriction. To be run at 2'.

Maiden Hunter: Open to horses and ponies in their first year of showing over fences at 2' or higher as of 12/1/20; no restrictions on riders.

Schooling Hunter: Open to all horses and ponies; no restriction on riders. To be run at 2'6" and 3'.

Working Hunter: Open to all horses and ponies not showing in any pony division; no restriction on riders. To be run at 3' & 3'6" rider's choice.

TB Hunter: Open to Thoroughbreds registered with the Jockey Club or eligible to be registered; no restriction on riders. To be run at 2'6" and 3'.

Green Hunter: Open to horses in their first or second year of showing over fences 2'6" or higher; no restriction on riders. To be run at 2'6".

Children's Hunter: Open to horses ridden by children. To be run at 2'6".

Adult Amateur Hunter: Open to horses ridden by adult amateurs. To be run at 2'6".

Pleasure: Open to horses ridden by adults or children and ponies ridden by children. Judged on performance and soundness with emphasis on manners.

Green Pony Hunter: Open to ponies in their first year of showing over fences. Small 2'; Medium 2'3"; Large 2'6".

Pony Hunter: Open to ponies 14.2 hands and under ridden by children. Small 2'; Medium 2'3"; Large 2'6".

Short Stirrup EQ and Hunter: Open to riders 12 years and under as of 12/1/20 on ponies/horses. Riders may not cross enter any class with jumps over 18". May trot or canter over fences. In Short Stirrup Hunter, mounts may not cross enter any other VHSA class except Pleasure and Equitation on the Flat.

Leadline: Open to riders 7 years and younger as of 12/1/20. Riders not allowed to cross enter into any classes where they would be asked to trot.

Pre-Short Stirrup Equitation: Open to riders 10 years and under as of 12/1/20. Riders may be asked to walk, trot, and perform simple Equitation tasks. Riders not allowed to cross enter into classes where they would be asked to canter or jump.

Forrest Tayloe Linton Memorial Classic: Open only to horses, ponies not allowed. No restrictions on riders. Jump heights to be 2'6" and 3', rider's choice. A two-round Classic judged as a hunter class using numeric scoring. The second round will be a Handy Hunter round and judged on promptness and handiness without affecting performance and style.

Forrest Tayloe Linton Pony Memorial Classic: Open to all ponies. Riders must be Juniors. A two-round Classic judged as a hunter class using the same format as horse classic with the following exceptions: Jump heights to be 2' or 2'6", rider's choice.

*All classes are covered by the rules and regulations of the current BHSA and VHSA rule books and will be conducted and judged accordingly.
The judge's decision is always final.*

Mini-clinic format, judges spend time giving reasons & suggestions to participants. All entrants in small rings receive a prize for each division.

- 1b) Lead Line (50% Pony 50% Child) DCA/BHSA (1b only)
- 2b) Lead Line (with poles & cones)
- 3b) Lead Line (detached w/handler)
- 4b) Pre-Short Stirrup Eq. Walk DCA/BHSA
- 5b) Pre-Short Stirrup Eq. Walk & trot
- 6b) Pre-Short Stirrup Eq. Walk, trot, jump position at a walk

Ring 2/Start: after Small Ring classes (not before 9 am)

(Schooling: 7am classes 7b-9b only) 120' x 184'

(open to all for schooling after 12b)

- 7b) Hunter Short Stirrup OF A 4 fences @ 18" VHSA/DCA
- 8b) Hunter Short Stirrup OF B 4 fences @ 18"
- 9b) Hunter Short Stirrup Under saddle
- 10b) Hunter Short Stirrup Eq. OF A 4 fences @ 18" (may trot) DCA/BHSA
- 11b) Hunter Short Stirrup Eq. OF B 4 fences @ 18" (may trot)
- 12b) Hunter Short Stirrup Eq. Under saddle (W/T/Indiv.canter)

Note: Pleasure classes are held in the grass ring to allow schooling in Ring 2 and grooming of the Main Ring without sacrificing time. Management may opt to hold Pleasure classes in the main ring. Management considerations are mainly based on daylight and weather.

Management reserves the right to combine and split classes and limit or organize warm-ups as needed. In general, to promote competition, classes are not split unless there can be 6 entries in each class and are combined if there are not 6 entries in each class.
